- Haguenau: one of the biggest lowland forests in France
 - Great Oak discovery footpath and may other hiking trails
- By the Rhine river**
- Original: cross the Rhine by the cable ferry at Seltz and the ferry at Drusenheim.
 - Gamsheim: one of the biggest fish ladders in Europe - the biggest locks on France's inland waterways
 - Offendorf: nature reserve - marina
 - Drusenheim: ferry
 - Seltz: cable ferry
 - Munchhausen: Nature and environmental learning centre - the second largest nature conservation park in Alsace.
 - Lauterbourg: fish ladder
